Entries will open on **Wednesday – May 06, 2026, at Noon**, at the club’s P.O. Box address. All entries received before this date will be returned. Overnight or certified mail must be sent with the “No Signature Required” waiver signed.

Entries close on **Wednesday – Jul 01, 2026, at Noon**, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered, or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Rules Applying to Dog Shows. Envelopes containing entries for more than ten (10) dogs will be treated as invalid and will be returned to the sender.

Transfers

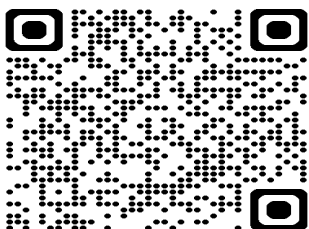
The request for a class transfer must be in writing and presented to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Transfers may be approved provided the class is available and has not reached its limit. Clubs are not required to accept transfers after closing of entries.

Entry Fees

Detective class entry fee is \$50.00, and all other classes are set at \$30.00 an entry. Each entry fee includes the American Kennel Club recording fee of \$4.50. Mail entry forms and fees to: Ores Chever Trial Secretary, PO Box 5455, Lakeland, FL, 33807.

Fax, Email, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on Official AKC Entry Form or photocopy of an entry form without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the entry form are not valid. Express Mail entries must clearly be marked “No Signature Required.”

Returned checks do not constitute valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

Wait List Information

IPOC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by entries withdrawn after the closing date/time. A maximum of fifty entries per day will be included on a wait list. No refund will be given after the closing date unless the entry can be replaced by an entry from the wait-listed entries. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait-listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. Any wait-listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

Essential Information

Staging Area will be out of view of search area(s). The staging area will include a waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The Handler's Briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each trial, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Dog in white has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during Handler's Briefing.

A warm-up area will be available consisting of ONE marked container of each odor being tested at the trial and may also consist of blank containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to two (2) minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler/dog team prior to their run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving the dog.

Condition of the Dog: Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the judge's opinion, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

High in Trial (HIT): Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in all elements offered (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried) and qualify in each are eligible to win High in Trial. One High in Trial winner is chosen per difficulty level. The High in Trial is determined by adding the team's faults across the elements. The team with the fewest faults is the winner. If there is a tie based on faults, then the team's times across elements will be summed up and the fastest team will win.

High Combined Division (HCD): Only teams who participate in the same difficulty level in an element plus Handlers Discrimination and qualify in each are eligible to win High Combined Division. The High Combined Division award is determined by adding a team's faults across all classes. The team with the fewest faults will be declared the winner of the High Combined Division. If there is a tie based on faults, then the teams' times across the classes will be summed, and the faster-finishing team will win.

An **Elite Title** is earned when a dog obtains ten qualifying scores during Odor Search Division Classes (Container, Interior, Exterior, Buried).

An **Elite Level Title** is earned when a dog obtains Elite titles in every element of the same difficulty level.

Additional Site Information.

Fax, Email, or unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an Official AKC Entry Form or photocopy of an entry form without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the official AKC entry form are not valid.

Females in season are **NOT** permitted to compete. If a female is withdrawn from competition because she came into season and the event secretary is notified in writing (written, email or text message) no later than one-half hour prior to the start of the first class in the trial, the entry fee will be refunded, less a processing fee of \$5.00 per class entry.

ENTRIES ARE LIMITED and will be taken on a first come first served basis, (so get your entries in early).

It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date.

Crating space: There is indoor crating space.

All dogs must be on leash at all times and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judges' searches.) An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without the benefit of a refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Spectator Area. Spectators may be limited by space constraints. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide.

Please be prepared for you and your canine partner to deal with varying environmental challenges. In order to preserve the integrity of the search areas, exhibitors will not be able to walk freely throughout the site.

Exhibitors **MUST** check in Each Day they are entered.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such a case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. IPOC and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. IPOC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against IPOC or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material. All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. You assume responsibility for damage caused to and/or by your dog (or yourself).

From I-4: Take Exit 27 (Polk Parkway – Highway 570) to the first exit (Airport Road) approximately three miles. Turn right onto Airport Road, go to the second light (Drane Field Road), and turn left. Then stay on Drane Field Road to Century Boulevard, which will be the first street (on the left) after the circle (across from the firehouse station). Turn into the industrial complex, then use the third driveway on the left. The IPOC building is straight ahead.



From Highway 60: Take Highway 60 to S. County Line Road. Go approximately five miles right on Drane Field Road. Stay on Drane Field road for approximately three miles to Century Boulevard, which will be the first street (on the left) after the circle (across from the firehouse station). Turn into the industrial complex, then use the third driveway on the left. The IPOC building is straight ahead.
